

## TAMSALING-GoN Agreement

A 19-point agreement had been signed between the Tamsaling Joint Struggle Committee and the Government Negotiation Team on 11 April 2009 (2065 /12/29). The discussion held on 4 August 09 (2066/4/20) in the presence of the Honourable Minister of Peace and Reconstruction regarding the status of the implementation of the Agreement was attended by the following persons.

### **Decisions:**

1. The Ministry of Local Development shall form a committee of experts according to Agreement number 13 to conduct a study for the implementation of a model development programme in the Tamsaling region for the upliftment and development of all the poor and oppressed

people including the Tamangs. The Committee shall also have the representation of the Tamangs.

2. Form a committee for Syambhu and Tamubuddha Development Region according to Agreement number 10 with the representation of Tamang communities.
3. Ensure the involvement of the people of other caste groups in *Pipa Goshwara* (now The Battalion for logistics support) and provide similar facilities that are provided to other Battalions of the army. Ensure appropriate representation of Tamang communities in Nepal Army.
4. Expedite the work regarding the survey design of outer Ring Road (outside the valley) according to Agreement number 15 with priority. Make provision of budget for this fiscal year also as in the previous fiscal year, and give continuity to the work of constructing the Ring Road.
5. The Government of Nepal shall make arrangements for the medical treatment of all those cadres and leaders who were injured during the strikes called by the Tamsaling Joint Struggle Committee.
6. Immediately initiate the process of revoking the cases levelled against the cadres and leaders, and release them after investigation and establishing their identity.
7. The aforesaid points that were agreed upon shall be implemented immediately. The other agreements shall be implemented gradually.
8. All the protest activities announced by the Tamslaing Joint Struggle Committee are withdrawn effective from today.
